## WHAT IS THE INTEROCEPTIVE SYSTEM?

THIS IS OUR SENSORY SYSTEM THAT HELPS US PROCESS INTERNAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE STATE OF OUR BODIES. THIS INCLUDES: FATIGUE, HUNGER, THIRST, TEMPERATURE, HEART RATE, EMOTIONS, DIGESTION AND RESPIRATION.

IT IS ONE OF THE THREE 'HIDDEN' SENSORY SYSTEMS.

THE INTEROCEPTIVE SYSTEM IS WHAT ALLOWS US TO FEEL & PROCESS:

HUNGER & THIRST

ANGER

SADNESS

HAPPINESS & JOY

THE SENSATION OF TAKING A DEEP BREATH

BEING TIRED







A CHILD MAY HAVE SENSORY PROCESSING CHALLENGES WITH INTEROCEPTION, SIGNS OF THIS MIGHT BE:

FEELS PAIN LESS THAN OTHERS\*

**INPUT** 

POOR UNDERSTANDING OF HOT OR COLD TEMPERATURES (I.E. RUNNING WATER, THE TEMPERATURE OF FOOD)\*

TOO HIGH OR LOW HEART RATE IN RESPONSE TO SENSORY INPUT (I.E. MAY GO TO INTO FIGHT/FLIGHT/FREEZE WITH A TYPICAL ACTIVITIES)\*

LATE TO LEARN TO USE THE POTTY

AROUSAL LEVELS ARE TOO HIGH OR TOO LOW THROUGHOUT THE DAY\*

MAY NOT REPORT THIRST OR HUNGER\*

\*IT IS ESSENTIAL YOU ARE EVALUATED BY A MEDICAL PROFESSIONAL TO DETERMINE IF THERE ARE OTHER

UNDERLYING MEDICAL CONDITIONS/FACTORS IMPACTING THE CHILD.
