# WHY OROMYOFUNCTIONAL THERAPY?

Oromyofunctional Disorders (OMD's) are any habit or condition that interferes with proper development and function of the orofacial muscles and facial structures. These can include tongue, lips, jaw and cheeks.

Treatment to correct abnormal functioning has been found to be 80-90% effective in resolving oromyofacial disorders. These include correcting resting postures and tongue function.
